“S”: **Schema**: Look at the headings of the section and write a brief description of what you already know about the topics. (It could be the first thought that pops into your mind about the topics.)

“T”: **Terms**: Write each of the vocabulary bold terms and write a brief description for each. Need to be in your own words. You are not copying the definition.

“I”: **Ideas**: After you have read the section, write down the main ideas.

“G”: **Gallery**: Apply the information you learned with the following activities. Each time you’ll be instructed how many of the activities you need to do.

Gallery Options

- Bubble Map: a vocab word goes in the center and you draw lines going out of the word attaching other words or phrases.
- Tree Map: one word is the main idea and it is connected to supporting ideas/topics of that main themed word.
- Acrostic poem: one word with descriptive phrases/sentences from each letter of original word.
- Riddle: Your riddle should have a minimum of four lines, should be written in the first person, and the last line should be “what am I?” Include the answer.
- Simile: write a simile for a vocab word: a simile uses like or as to compare two things or ideas.
- Cinquain: Write a poem for a vocab word using the following format.
